



SELECTING THE RIGHT SPECIALIST

After obtaining the right documentation form, have it completed by a licensed or properly credentialed specialist qualified to diagnose your disability and recommend reasonable accommodations for your university program. The disability specialist that you select **must complete the entire form** or you will not be able to be accommodated by NUHS Disability Support Services.

These specialists are qualified to complete a disability documentation form:

- **AD/HD (Attention Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder)**
Clinical Psychologist, Neuropsychologist, Psychiatrist, Neurologist, or Neurodevelopmental Physician
- **Asperger's Syndrome**
Clinical Psychologist, Neuropsychologist, Psychiatrist, Neurologist, or Neurodevelopmental Physician
- **Low Vision or Blindness**
Ophthalmologist or Optometrist
- **Deaf or Hard of Hearing**
Audiologist or Otolaryngologist
- **Learning Disabilities**
School Psychologist, Clinical Psychologist, Neuropsychologist, or Neurodevelopmental Physician
- **Physical, Chronic Illness or Mobility Disabilities**
Licensed physicians who are qualified to evaluate and diagnose mobility or chronic health disabilities such as: Chiropractic, Osteopathic, or Allopathic Physician, or other physician specialist with advanced training and knowledge related to the disability, for example: Orthopedic Surgeon, Gastroenterologist, etc.
- **Psychological Disabilities**
Documentation must be performed by a licensed or credentialed authority with specific training or expertise related to the condition being diagnosed such as: Psychiatrist, Clinical Psychologist, Social Worker (LICSW), or Psychiatric Nurse Practitioner.
- **TBI or ABI (Traumatic or Acquired Brain Injury)**
The evaluation must be performed by a professional who is knowledgeable about brain injuries and qualified to make appropriate recommendations. This would include a physician, neurologist, licensed clinical psychologist or rehabilitation psychologist, neuropsychologist, or psychiatrist.
